Ever since April 2009, after French company Sodexo took over Radhakrishna Hospitality Services (RKHS), 41-year-old **Sunil Nayak** has been the CEO of the company in India. "The big switch that the organisation has made is in the range of services. From catering and food services, we have entered food courts, hospitals, educational institutions, as well as facilities management," says Nayak, who heads the Rs700 crore operation that improves the quality of daily life of its clients. "To grow the business, we are slowly phasing out the RKHS brand and concentrating on Sodexo working with one integrated team," he adds. Nayak targets an annual growth rate of 25 per cent, positioned as a comprehensive solutions provider on a pan-



India basis, with 55 per cent of the topline coming from on-site services (food and services comprising staff restaurant, catering, executive dining, vending, meal delivery, etc), 20 per cent from remote site management (rigs and barges), and the balance from facilities management. ♦
